Dear Odyssey of the Mind Membership Coordinator,

Welcome back and thank you for all you do for the children of Gulf Coast Region. On behalf of the entire Regional Board, good luck to all teams! This may be the most important information we give to you this year, so please take the time to read all six pages carefully, make the appropriate copies, and distribute them to EVERYONE who needs to know this information.

Included, please find: (If you're downloading this letter, make sure you download all forms)

- A "2011-2012 Gulf Coast Important Dates" - an overview of all registration due dates and team activities – COPY AND GIVE TO COACHES.
- A "Regional Membership Registration" form, also known as the "Coordinator's Form": As coordinator, your responsibility is to collect ALL fees and forms from ALL teams and USE THE INFORMATION TO REGISTER THE TEAMS, WORKERS, AND JUDGES ONLINE. This form serves as an overview of your TOTAL membership and as proof that ALL ADULTS associated with a team are approved volunteers. This form must be sent to the regional director by December 15, 2011.
- A "Team Registration" form: Complete **one per team**. Use the form to complete a team registration online by **December 15**. The names listed online will be compared to the team's "Outside Assistance" form submitted at each level of competition. KEEP THE FORM.

Teams may be paid for online with a credit card at www.floridaodysseyofthemind.org. Paying the registration fee locks the team's roster, after which changes can't be made, so be sure you have the roster information entered before generating an

invoice or paying with a credit card. **ALL TEAMS MUST BE REGISTERED ONLINE BY THE DEADLINE.**

•A “Worker” form - **Each team** is required to provide one adult to work a two-hour shift on the day of competition or setup the evening before. Workers monitor doors, keep time, run errands, and otherwise help us make sure the regional tournament is successful. We will make sure a worker is not scheduled at the same time his or her team is competing. Workers less than 18 years of age (16 or 17) or still in high school must be pre-approved by the regional director **BEFORE** registering the worker online. A maximum of two workers between the ages of 16 and 18 will be approved per membership. Workers must be registered online by December 15. **KEEP THE FORM.**

•A “Judge Registration” form - **Each team** is required to provide one judge for the regional competition. This person agrees to attend judge’s training (February 25) and to judge at the regional competition (MARCH 10). This **two-sided** form has several questions necessary to properly place the judge. Use the info to register the judge online by **December 15.** **KEEP THE FORM.**

If a large membership has difficulty securing enough judges, the coordinator may request that ONE judge be a junior or senior in high school, **but this must be approved by the regional director BEFORE registering the judge.**

Judges are committed to one area the whole day of competition and can’t leave to see their own child compete in another problem, so teachers, guidance counselors, and administrators make good prospects for judges. Judges are the heart of a quality tournament. For us to ensure a successful experience for the participants, ALL judges must commit to and attend the training, or teams will be penalized. Experienced spontaneous judges may be excused from the training, but not until they receive word from the spontaneous problem captain. I will notify a judge by e-mail of his/her assignment.

ALERT: Every adult WORKER, JUDGE, OR COACH for any Pasco County Public School Odyssey of the Mind team must be an approved volunteer who has been screened according to district regulations. Coordinators must insure this requirement is met.

•An “Ad” form - The regional tournament requires funds for custodial services, printing costs, the program, T-shirts for judges, and other miscellaneous expenses. To pay for this, we are requiring **each team** to sell \$75.00 worth of ads for our regional tournament program. The ad prices are listed on the form. Please copy the form as many times as needed. **The due date for all ads is December 15, 2011.** This is our region’s main source of income. We need every membership to meet this requirement.

PLEASE PUT YOUR MEMBERSHIP NAME ON THE AD FORM BEFORE COPYING IT FOR YOUR COACHES. REMIND YOUR COACHES TO PRINT THE NAME OF THEIR TEAM ON THE FORM BEFORE GIVING IT OUT TO FAMILIES, BUSINESSES, ETC. Any team that sells \$500 or more in ads will receive recognition at the awards ceremony AND \$20 per team member to spend at the regional tournament sales table!

•"Regional T-Shirt Order" Form – We have a lovely t-shirt design this year and we are priced competitively with the state merchandise. I'll send the artwork when it's available or you can check the regional website periodically. The deadline for ordering a regional shirt is **December 15**. Shirts will be available for pick up at the mandatory coach's meeting on February 25. **SEND ONE CHECK PER SCHOOL TO COVER ALL T-SHIRT ORDERS, PLEASE!** Checks are made payable to Florida Odyssey of the Mind.

•"Scholarship" Form - Any graduating senior who has participated in the Odyssey of the Mind program as a team member for a minimum of two years can apply for this scholarship. The scholarship(s) will be awarded at the regional tournament awards ceremony.

•"Spontaneous Workshop Registration" Form – We're planning THREE this year: one on the eastside, one in the middle north, and one on the westside! Bring your teams to ONE of the workshops and let them practice their spontaneous skills in a variety of situations. This event is a ton of creative fun, so be sure to register and attend. The form is due by **December 1**. All teams must register. This year we are adding two whole group sessions to each workshop. One will be on stage presence and one will be on structure tips and techniques for weight placement. We will NOT discuss this year's problems, but rather focus on skills needed to perform.

•School Banners Information – You'll need a banner for the awards ceremony. Read the form carefully.

Well, that's it for now. If you're feeling a bit overwhelmed, please call or email me with any questions or concerns you may have. Please note that I am using the email address, fabercro@pasco.k12.fl.us for all correspondence. Also, feel free to attend the coach's training, even if you're an experienced coach. We will be there to offer support and assistance. I look forward to seeing you at trainings, workshops, meetings, and of course, for the Regional Tournament AT CHARLES S. RUSHE MIDDLE SCHOOL on March 10, 2012. Until then, good luck!

More Very Important Stuff

- **The regional tournament site is different from the awards ceremony location. Make sure your teams and families know where both are. It's very important that all teams attend the awards ceremony. Don't let them self-judge and assume they aren't going on to state. It's not about winning; it's about solving the problem and fulfilling your commitment. Don't let them quit.**
- **Last year a number of teams were less than cooperative when it came to trash disposal and many guests were dangerous with their parking decisions. Therefore, this year the region will incur the additional expenses of parking enforcement officials and extra dumpsters. We will need each team to meet their ad quota if we are to cover these additional expenses. Please remind your teams and families to take extremely good care of our host sites. Our program thrives because of the generous support of Pasco County schools.**
- **Each team is required to provide one worker and one judge. If you provide more than one judge or worker per team, that's very helpful for the region, BUT PLEASE DON'T register multiple judges and/or workers with the idea that the extra adults are "back up" or "just in case" the required adult doesn't show up. We train, schedule, and rely on the extras the same as the required. Therefore, ALL WORKERS AND JUDGES WHO ARE REGISTERED AND SCHEDULED ARE EXPECTED TO FULFILL THEIR OBLIGATION OR THE TEAM WILL BE PENALIZED.**
- **PLEASE keep judges informed and reminded of the training and tournament dates. Do NOT just sign up people with the intention of finding a "real" person later. It's time consuming and confusing to reorganize dozens of judges two days before training.**
- **You can order state merchandise on the Florida Odyssey of the Mind website at www.floridaodysseyofthemind.org.**
- **Please be sure to supply current e-mail addresses for all judges, coaches, and workers whenever possible. Most notifications will be issued by e-mail. If you give an e-mail address, please be sure to actually read your e-mail regularly. Thanks!**
- **Primary teams have the same obligations as all other teams: one judge, one worker, ads, paperwork, etc. One or more primary teams will represent the Gulf Coast Region at the State Tournament. The team will not compete, but will perform in both long term and spontaneous. The team will be chosen by random drawing from interested teams at the regional tournament awards ceremony.**

How a membership raises money to pay the costs associated with participating in the Odyssey of the Mind program is up to the membership's administration. Some memberships hold fundraisers, some secure business sponsors, some charge participants a fee, and some use a combination of these methods. Regardless of how the money is secured, all registration money must be filtered through the membership according to its bookkeeping regulations. Ad money and t-shirt orders may be paid directly to Florida Odyssey of the Mind or filtered through the membership as directed by the administration.

THIS JUST IN.....

- 1) According to district field trip guidelines, ALL teams representing a Pasco County Public School, must be accompanied by a school board employee when traveling out of county.**
- 2) That school board employee must be with the team for the duration of the trip.**
- 3) One employee canNOT represent more than one team.**
- 4) All teams coached only by parents will need a school board employee to accompany the team in order to compete at the state or world level.**
- 5) This applies to all divisions.**
- 6) There are currently no exceptions, so this applies even if EVERY team member's parent travels with the team.**
- 7) Each team must complete official field trip forms during the week following the competition in which they earned the right to move up to the next level.**
