

DISNEY GIVE-A-DAY, GET-A-DAY PROGRAM

The Gulf Coast Odyssey of the Mind Regional Tournament qualifies for the Disney program. The following people can sign up: **COACHES, JUDGES, ALL-DAY WORKERS, REGIONAL BOARD MEMBERS**. This is NOT an opportunity for kids, two-hour volunteer workers, or parent helpers. Coaches and Judges MUST BE REGISTERED on the state website to qualify.

A. Go to

B. Put in the zip code of the tournament: 34654

C. Choose Children & Youth in Volunteer Opportunity Interest Area menu

D. We come up first on the list or look for Gulf Coast Regional Tournament. Click on details and you'll see:

To volunteer for this opportunity, you'll need to follow 3 **important** steps before you can sign up for the "Give a Day. Get a Disney Day." program. **You will not be registered for the "Give a Day. Get a Disney Day" program if you do not follow all three of these steps:**

1. Fill out the express interest form below to email Florida Odyssey of the Mind and arrange a date and time to volunteer. They will respond to your email within the next 5 days.

2. Confirm with the organization the date and time you will volunteer. They may contact you by email and tell you they have scheduled you to volunteer on a certain date — but this does not mean you are signed up for the program. You must complete step 3 or you will not be registered.

3. After you confirm a date and time and **before you volunteer**, please open the email sent by HandsOn Network with the subject *[VOP] Your "Give A Day. Get A Disney Day." program volunteer opportunity inquiry*. Please confirm that the email corresponds with the organization you confirmed a date and time to volunteer with in step 2. By clicking on the enclosed link, you will return to this website and proceed to sign up for this volunteer opportunity where you will enter the date and time you agreed to volunteer.

E. Be very sure you add the following phrase in the details box: **"I am a coach/judge for (name of school and/or problem)."** That way, I don't spend time contacting you to explain the program.

F. Finally, do step 3 BEFORE THE TOURNAMENT DATE.
